Conditions of Play

1. Overview

The tournament shall be conducted by Western Suburbs Badminton Association Inc.; (Host Association) on behalf of Badminton Australia (BA) and will be subject to these Conditions of Play, the relevant Badminton Australia By-Laws and the relevant Badminton World Federation (BWF) Competition Regulations.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify from any or all events, any player infringing these Conditions of Play or in any way interfering with the conduct of the tournament.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend or add to these Conditions of Play as necessary.

2. Entries

Entries shall be accepted from teams/players from any State or Territory within the boundaries and affiliated to either the Australian Badminton Association or the New Zealand Badminton Federation, and additional teams representing nations affiliated to the BWF, subject also to the provisions of 27.3.

Entry Fees must be paid prior to commencement of play. Refunds are at the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee of the Host Association.

No refunds will be made after the draw has been published, except where the tournament or event is abandoned and then, only at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

3. List of events

Teams event ~ held over two – three days depending on entries

Will consist of round robin format, with a minimum of two boys and two girls in the team. Each tie will consist of two boys and two girls singles, one boy's and one girl's doubles, and two mixed doubles. No player may play in more than one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles in any tie.

Individual event ~ held over two – three days depending on entries

This is a knock out event where entries will be received for the following events:

- Boys Singles Championship
- Girls Singles Championship
- Boys Doubles Championship
- Girls Doubles Championship
- Mixed Doubles Championship.

The boys and girls singles, boys and girls doubles and mixed doubles will be played in accordance with the BWF Competition Regulations.

If there are sufficient entries and time allowing plate events will be held at the discretion of the tournament organising committee.

Players who have made themselves available for team selection but not selected are eligible to enter the individuals. The state or territory body must authorize entries.

4. Key Operational Requirements

- All players must report to the Tournament Controller at least 15 minutes prior to the indicated starting time for their match and must play as directed, or forfeit the match.
- Players not ready to play 5 minutes after a match has been called will be defaulted.
- Warm up time will be limited to 3 minutes after a match has been called.
- Players must be attired in correct clothing as per BWF Competition Regulations. Players not correctly attired may be disqualified.



- Any player participating in the tournament must, when called upon, act as Umpire or Line Judge. Failure to comply with this condition renders a player liable to disqualification.

5. Shuttles

Epsilon shuttles will be used exclusively throughout the tournament. Two speeds of shuttles will be offered.

6. Referees

All decisions of the Referee (or responsible official) in relation to the Laws of Badminton and relevant Competition Regulations and By-Laws shall be final.

7. Anti-Doping Requirements

Badminton players in this tournament may be subject to *In - Competition* drug testing. Badminton players, coaches, officials and administrators of this tournament are subject to the Badminton Australia Anti-Doping Policy, which has been endorsed by each State/Territory Association. You can obtain a copy of the policy from the Badminton Australia website – www.badminton.org.au - or by phoning the Badminton Australia Office – 03 9397 4722.

If you are from overseas and have entered via your National Federation in this tournament – contact your National Badminton Association for advice about TUE applications and processes (see below).

Medications

Some medications contain prohibited substances. If a player suffers from a medical condition, which can only be treated by medication containing a prohibited or banned substance, they must get approval to use this medication. Please see the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority website - www.asada.gov.au and or call the ASADA Hotline - 1800 020 506. THIS IS THE ATHLETE'S RESPONSIBILITY. There are two types of processes:

1. ATUE – Abbreviated Therapeutic Use Exemption Process

For restricted substances which require notification such as many asthma medications (check the ASADA hotline – 1800 020 506). Complete the ATUE form with your doctor and submit this to Badminton Australia – Fax 03 9397 4733 or send to The Medical Officer, Badminton Australia, 15/8 Techno Park Drive, Williamstown, VIC 3016. 2. TUE – Therapeutic Use Exemption Process

For all prohibited substances. For all other conditions and use of medications with banned substances, submit the TUE Form to the Australian Sports Drug Medical Advisory Committee (ASDMAC) with supporting medical documentation.
